Development & Recommendation of players to PDP by Coach, DOC & PDP Scouts.

PDP (free of charge)

Identification, Showcase to National Team, Professional Club, College. Training, testing, homework, feedback, monitor development of player.

Collaboration with USSF with “MTC” and Professional Clubs.

College showcase

National Team

(free of charge)

“MTC” USSF program identify & recommend players to National Camp.

Professional

Clubs (free of charge)

Visit from various Professional Clubs in NorCal to identify players at PDP showcases. Invitation/Monitor for players to attend training at the Professional Clubs.

College showcases

(free of charge)

Showcase Teams “Play Date” at common site .

Two training a month

One week-end format in 2-3 different location
- College days – Girls (Ideally 4 to 6)

Future Development:

- Future PDP teams meeting with other National Premier League PDP
- Future Scouting Program

2012 Player Recommendation Process:

- Club DOC or Club Coach will fill out Player Recommendation Form online (wufoo)
- Using Demosphere's player data base (accurate & doc - coach email attached to player information)

Window of time when to recommend players

- **1st window:** Jan 1st to Feb 8th blasting multiple emails to inform all clubs to recommend players (over 900 as of Feb 8th)
- **2nd window:** 1 week in April follow with a specific training date for new players to show up for evaluation.
- **3rd window:** 1 week late July or early August same as 2nd window.
